Target group

Credits

English requirements

You must have English on minimum B2 level.

Cost

There is no participation fee for this international week. Expenses related to travelling, accommodation, food, personal costs are not covered.

Accommodation

We have prebooked rooms at the local hostel from Sunday to Friday. The rate is app. 130 euros for all nights. You will sleep in rooms with 4 to 8 persons.

Registration

You must be nominated by your international coordinator, whereafter we will send you a link to our registration portal. Nomination must be send to International Consultant Anne Jeppesen on acje@ucsyd.dk. Deadline for nomination is 15th of January 2024. The course is limited to 20 incoming students.

How to get to Haderslev

You can fly to Billund airport and take a bus to either Kolding or Vejle and then a bus to the bus station in Haderslev. If you are driving to Haderslev on highway E45 (A7 from Germany), take exit 68 (Vojens) and turn right towards Haderslev. If you come by train, you will have to go to Vojens and from there take a bus to Haderslev. Plan your trip in Denmark on www.rejseplanen.dk
